The Adopt-A-Space program engages community support to assist in the beautification of landscaped areas, traffic islands and other green spaces owned by the City of Marlborough.

The program was initiated in 1999 by Mayor Vigeant in his role as City Councilor. The program has met success due to numerous participants. As the years have passed, the Adopt-A Space team has discovered ways to improve the program and make participation easier.

Participating is simple—it requires a donation of just \$100 for seasonal adoption.

Adoption includes the use of a commercial 28" wide x 28" high planter, as well as the plants. Planters will be full with beautiful and hardy flowers and will be placed in early summer at a downtown location selected by each adopter, and will be adorned with a sign noting the committed adopter's name(s) or company(ies). Planters may also be adopted in memorial tribute.

The adoption application can be accessed from the City's Website. A list of available sites is included in the application.
