remove all debris  
(styrofoam,  
plastic, etc.) and  
flatten boxes  
before recycling

Comingled: paper,  
kitchen plastics,  
water bottles, tin  
cans, rinsed clean.  
(No plastic bags)

Glass Bottles and  
Jars: rinsed clean,  
placed in designated  
black bins

Aluminum Cans:  
emptied cans can be  
placed in designated  
black bins
