RESIDENTS OF MARLBOROUGH – Collection of old plastic rubbish containers and/or recycling bins

The City of Marlborough, Department of Public Works is pleased to announce that beginning Saturday, July 21, 2012 at 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM the city will be accepting old rubbish container(s) and/or unwanted recycling bin(s). Only plastic containers and bins from 1-family, 2-family and 3-family residential properties, and condominiums will be accepted. The hours of operation, duration and location for this collection site are as follows:

Location: Department of Public Works, 135 Neil Street
Time: Saturday, July 21, 2012 – 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM*
Monday through Friday - 8 AM to 3 PM
(July 23, 2012 through August 10, 2012)

*This is the only scheduled Saturday for drop-off at the DPW.

Please note the following requirements/restrictions listed below will apply and be strictly enforced:

1. Marlborough residents (ONLY).
2. Plastic and/or rubber rubbish container(s) and recycling bins.
3. No commercial vehicles.
4. Proof of residency (license, registration, tax bill)
5. Trailers in lieu of pickup trucks will only be allowed if bed size is the same size as pickup truck.
