February 1, 2011 - A message from Mayor Nancy Stevens

During these current snow events, I would like to remind residents of some important snow emergency information, policies, and recommended practices.

- There will be no trash or recyclables pick up on Wednesday, February 2nd. Routes for the remainder of the week will be delayed by one day. For example, Wednesday routes will be picked up on Thursday, February 3rd; Thursday routes will be picked up on Friday; Friday routes will be picked up on Saturday.
- We request that residents place their trash and recycling in their driveways or sidewalk areas, not in the roadway.
- Please remember that the winter parking ban remains in effect. There is no parking allowed on City streets between the hours of 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. Residents may use the two municipal parking garages for overnight parking. There are no exceptions to the parking ban during snow events, so please spread the word that parking is not allowed. In addition, cars impeding snow clearing operations will be towed.
- As a reminder, it is illegal to deposit snow in a public way. Please do not shovel, snow blow, or plow snow into the roadway. Additionally, please clean snow from the roof of all vehicles. Drivers failing to do so, can and will be ticketed.
- We ask residents for your cooperation and assistance in helping to remove snow around the City's fire hydrants.
- Be mindful that excess snow, particularly on flat roofs can be dangerous. If your home has a gas vent, please remember to keep it clear to avoid the possibility of carbon monoxide build-up.
- Decisions on school closures are made on a daily basis.
- Due to this week's weather, the deadline for payment of property taxes has been extended until Friday, Feb. 4 at 5:00 p.m.
