

RESIDENTS OF MARLBOROUGH – Recycling and solid waste moving back to Resident Drop-off Facility

The City of Marlborough, Department of Public Works is pleased to announce that the reconstruction of the Resident Drop-off Facility (RDF) located at 856 Boston Post Road East is almost completed. We are anticipating moving the recyclables from the temporary site back to the new facility on Monday, November 3, 2014 while the outstanding work is being completed. We anticipate approximately three more weeks to complete all work associated with this project. We intend to continue utilizing the temporary yard waste, leave, grass clipping and brush collection set up at this facility until such time as it can be relocated to the other side when the last phase is completed.

Below please find a list of acceptable materials allowed at this facility and the hours of operation.

Batteries
Fluorescent Bulbs
Propane Tanks (small gas grill type)
Air Conditioners/Refrigerators*

The city's fall yard waste collection will begin on Monday, November 3, 2014 through November 29, 2014. Please note this separate collection does not change or affect your automated solid waste and recyclables collection on Friday's under our existing program. Please continue to place your wheeled cart(s) curbside by 7:00 AM on Friday's for collections (during the 4-week yard waste collection period) along with your yard waste material you want collected. You will still be able to utilize the Resident Drop-off Facility during this final phase of reconstruction for disposal of grass clipping and your yard waste needs.
