Re: Monthly meeting @ Central Fire Station 215 Maple Street, January 16th, 2013 @ 9:00 AM in Classroom.

1. DPW Radio UHF has been programmed to all vehicles and a new Repeater installed at Sligo Hill. First storm it has worked very good for a temporary system. Request sent to Windham, CT Police for use of 800MHz for the DPW, still working on it.
2. FEMA MEMA Funds received for October storm \$472,366.10 75% of expenditures.
3. The Point to Point is being installed as of this week at the four locations. It should be up and running in two weeks. This will include the 800 MHz for the DPW when the license is received.
4. This week also the new fire alarm system is being installed. The new AES system should be ready for new installations or up-grade of present fire alarm systems by end of month.
5. April Drill with Marlborough Hospital is still on schedule. Planning meeting should be taking place shortly.
6. Meeting set with National Grid to go over the Emergency Response Data for the City.
7. Storm Sandy, the Middlesex County did not meet the criteria for a Presidential award.
8. Working with Conservation Officer about getting more information about chemicals being used in the water shed area.
9. New equipment for the EOC has come in and is being installed: Radios, TV, new cables, etc.
10. Bouvier Pharmacy, oxygen for shelter and homebound during power outages.
11. Anything, anyone has to offer or request to be addressed presently or for the future.
